When something says for example C/G, this means that you're to play a C chord, but with a G as the bass note. As another example, if it says G/B, you play a G chord with a B in the bass. Don't know these chords? Well then I'll probably write them in at the bottom of this document.

"But these feet are mine" bit: (in this bit you hold onto the C9 and the G/B for twice as long as you did in the broken bones bit before)

Verse Same chords as intro, except this time you're strumming them. Use your thumb to get the third fret on the thickest E string, and then also use it to gently touch and mute the A string which has the x on it.
